We are asking you to choose whether to volunteer for a research study about numbing the eye before eye injections. We are asking you because you are getting an eye injection and need numbing medicine first. This page is to give you key information to help you decide if you want to take part. There is detailed information after this page. Ask the research team questions. If you have questions later, you can use the bold phone number or email address at the bottom of this page to talk to the person in charge of this study.

What is the study about?

We hope this study will help us find out the best way to numb the eye before an eye injection and make our clinic practices better. We will record information about:

- the medicines we use
- your pain level for the injection
- how we numb your eye
- some personal information (like age, race, etc.)

This study will not affect which treatment you get today.

Your part in this study will last about 1 hour, the length of your visit today.

And how long will it last?

What are some reasons you might want to volunteer?

You might want to volunteer for this study because it could help us learn the best way to numb the eye before eye injections.

You might not want to volunteer if:

- you don't want us to keep and use your information
- you don't want to answer questions during today's visit

What are some reasons you might NOT want to volunteer?

No, you do not have to take part in this study. If you volunteer, it should be because you really want to. You will not lose any rights, services, or benefits if you choose not to take part in this study.
